

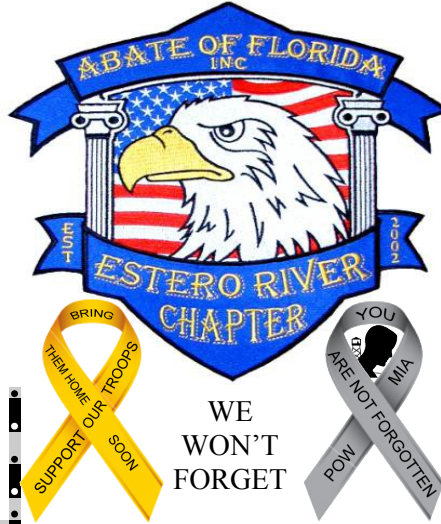

LEGISLATIVE REPORT-DECEMBER 2011

Following are some legislative tidbits not specifically motorcycle related but should be of interest to all of us as Florida residents and drivers. This month is the pause before the Legislative session begins in January.

POSSIBLE ROAD TOLLS

The State Department of Transportation plans to try to replace dwindling gas tax revenue with additional tolling ability, particularly for express lanes. This will be part of the department's agency omnibus bill, containing much of its legislative agenda. It won't likely be filed until the deadline for filing bills, the first day of the legislative session in January, to allow for changes to be made without having to do it in the formal committee process through amendments.

The DOT has said for several months that it envisions additional tolling authority as a major part of its solution to the drop in gas tax revenue that the state has seen. That drop is blamed in large part on the increasing fuel efficiency of vehicles. Transportation Secretary Ananth Prasad, who has pushed for the additional tolling authority, has said that DOT only plans to pursue tolls on new roads or bridges, or new lanes, particularly express lanes that would be added to roadways, giving drivers a choice to pay a toll to take a lane that might not be congested.

State transportation officials also say that the new express lanes benefit even those who don't use them, by reducing congestion in the other lanes since express lane users are removed. But at the time, much of the objection to the tolls was said to be the lines that formed at toll booths. Most new toll roads would likely involve automatic tolling through SunPass-type devices or license plate photos, state officials have said, thus removing lines from toll plazas.

U.S. TRANSPORTATION SECRETARY LAHOOD ANNOUNCES FINAL RULE THAT BANS HAND-HELD CELL PHONES USE BY DRIVERS OF BUSES AND LARGE TRUCKS

The U.S. Transportation Secretary announced on November 23, 2011 a final rule specifically prohibiting interstate truck and bus drivers from using hand-held cell phones while operating their vehicles. The joint rule from the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA) and the Pipeline and Hazardous Material Safety Administration (PHMSA) is the latest action by the U.S. Department of Transportation to end distracted driving. The rule prohibits commercial drivers from using a hand-held mobile telephone while operating a commercial truck or bus. Drivers who violate the restriction will face federal civil penalties of up to \$2,750 for each offense and disqualification from operating a commercial vehicle for multiple offenses. Additionally, states will suspend a driver's commercial driver's license (CDL) after two or more serious traffic violations. Commercial truck and bus companies that allow their drivers to use hand-held cell phones while driving will face a maximum penalty of \$11,000. Approximately four million commercial drivers would be affected by

this rule.

Nearly 5,474 people died and a half a million were injured in crashes involving a distracted driver in 2009. Distraction-related fatalities represented 16 percent of overall traffic fatalities in 2009, according to National Highway Traffic Administration (NHTSA) research.

4 NEW TRAUMA CENTERS TO BE OPENED

The first couple of hours are VERY critical for someone that has been severely injured in a crash. The sooner they can get to a trauma center the better their odds of survival. It doesn't matter if it is a crash on a motorcycle, car or whatever, getting to a trauma center is critical.

ABATE of Florida, Inc. is represented on the Motorcycle Safety Coalition, which includes people from the Dept. of Health (DOH) and one of their leading trauma surgeons. One of the big goals of the DOH is to educate paramedics, LEO's, and regular ER staff to the type of trauma patients that need immediate evacuation to the nearest trauma center. Specifically, they are educating the first responder about motorcycle crashes and the need for quick and proper assessment and evacuation to the proper medical setting. The DOH on 11/25/11 gave the go-ahead to trauma centers at Orange Park Medical Center in Clay County, Regional Medical Center Bayonet Point in Pasco County, Blake Medical Center in Manatee County and Kendall Regional Medical Center in Miami-Dade County---all part of the HCA hospital chain. HCA last year announced a push to add trauma centers at hospitals in Florida. In a news release, Regional Medical Center for Bayonet Point touted the approval of its trauma center as the "next step in the evolution" of the hospital.

There are 22 Verified Trauma Centers in the state of Florida with 19 service areas. In South Florida there are 4 in Hillsborough County, 2-Palm Beach Co., 3 -Broward Co., 2-Dade Co., and 1-Lee Co. (Lee Memorial Hospital) which services Lee, Charlotte, Hendry and Glades Counties. Note: Collier County is in a Non-service area.

SENATE PANEL PROPOSES 2012 REDISTRICTING MAPS

Drawing on 157 redistricting maps submitted by citizens and on testimony by more than 1,600 people across the state, the Florida Senate published proposed redistricting plans for congressional and senate districts. The plans, which can be found at www.flsenate.gov/redistricting, will define boundaries for voting districts for the next ten years, beginning with the 2012 elections. All Floridians are encouraged to review the proposed plans and provide their comments and suggestions. The proposal was developed by the Senate Reapportionment Committee based on bipartisan guidelines agreed to by all 24 of the Democrats and Republicans on the committee. All directions to staff and committee procedures have been agreed to in a bipartisan manner by the Senate Majority Leader, Andy Gardiner and the Senate Minority Leader, Nan Rich. Also agreed to unanimously were instructions to staff to preserve minorities' access to the po-

litical system and avoid retrogression.

APPEALS COURT OKAYS LOCAL RED LIGHT CAMERA LAW

A state appeals court ruled 11/30/11 that the use of cameras by the city of Aventura and several others to catch red light runners is valid, overruling a lower court that had found the use of the devices before a new state law was enacted illegal. The majority of the three judge panel of the Third District Court of Appeal in Miami said that Aventura, which had red light cameras in place before a 2010 state law that specifically allows them, was within the law. The bill passed by the Legislature in 2010 now pre-empts municipal regulation of red light cameras, but Aventura and several other cities had the enforcement mechanisms in place before the law was passed. The appeal court noted that the new law specifically didn't invalidate pre-existing camera systems, but moved their regulation to the state. The case is City of Aventura vs Richard Masone.

GAMBLING ESTIMATES

With destination gambling on the tips of Capitol tongues, state economists took a shot at estimating the anticipated revenue of such gaming ventures in Florida. A panel of economists from the Legislature and the governor's office met to take a look at a proposal to allow up to three resort casinos in South Florida. The economic impact of such mega casino resorts remains a moving target and changes dramatically depending on whose talking. One player, Genting Group, has said the state could reap \$400 to \$600 million in revenue to the state each year if three resorts are allowed to build in South Florida. In a meeting 12/2/11, state economists said destination resorts could have an impact of up to \$155 million in the 2012-13 fiscal year and by 2015-16 an impact of between \$24.3 million and \$118.9 million. This is a slightly higher estimate than a previous figure released in November. Economists noted the estimates do not include local property tax revenue derived from the developments.
