

Senate bill 1100 was the Highway Safety bill that Representative Greg Evers placed Abate's amendment on that deleted the \$1000 fine for the vertical license plate. Senate bill 2282 was the first responder's bill. That stopped Cities and Counties in Florida from charging you for Police and Firemen to come to an accident. Those fees are covered under the taxes you pay to them and you should not be double taxed.

The 2010 election process has already begun for the state of Florida and the US Senate seat open and all congressional seats. There will be many candidates running and now is the time to start thinking about who you want to see as Governor of this state and in the Florida legislature. Abate has been very successful in the past getting pro motorcycling people elected and if we are to move the motorcycle effort forward we must do it again. Dear Fellow ABATE Members,

Who is **Your** Father?

Yesterday, on our way to church service we wondered if during the service, there was going to be something on the topic of fathers. It was Father's Day! In our minds, we were thinking about the problems many people have relating to God, because of the relationship they've had with their natural father. Let's think about that.

Why would people have a problem relating to God the Father? Is it because of the relationship and/or lack of one with their natural father? Maybe because...

1. The natural father was never in the home. 2. The natural father deserted his home. 3. The natural father disinherited you. 3. The natural father wasn't a good role model. 4. The natural father didn't show affection. 5. The natural father abused you. 6. The natural father abused your mother and/or other members of the family. 6. The natural father spent more time with other people and interests outside of the family. 7. The natural father was more interested in his needs than yours. From your personal experience, can you add to this list?

A lot of times, we hold the blame of what has gone wrong in our lives, because of the relationship we have had with our natural father. And, as we grow older, we transfer a lot of what has gone wrong by blaming it on God. Many times, we may find it easy to just go along with others when they blame God for what is wrong in their lives. If your own father has let you down in any way, then you can accept God the Father for who He is and know that His love is unconditional.

You can have a relationship with the God the Father, beyond what you've ever have experienced with your own natural father (even if it was a good experience). First, we'll describe a few of God's promises in a relationship with Him. Then, we'll describe how to have that relationship.

- 1. You are His child: John 1:12
- 2. The Father's love for you is everlasting: Romans 8:38-39
- 3. Nothing can separate you from the Father's love: Romans 8:35-37
- 4. You can be free from condemnation: Romans 8:1-2
- 5. He will be there in times of need: Hebrews 4:16

God the Father will give you power, love, and a sound mind: 2 Timothy 1:7

Just a couple more promises: Philippians 4:19 and Numbers 23:19

How can we have that relationship to the Father? Colossians 1:15 and 2 Corinthians 4:4 tells us that Jesus is the image of the invisible God, referring to His very nature. It also tells us that the devil has blinded unbelievers to this fact. 2 Corinthians 1:20 says that, "²⁰For no matter how many promises God has made, they are "Yes" in Christ. And so through him the "Amen" is spoken by us to the glory of God." You can count on the promises of God. Jesus said, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No man cometh to the Father except by Me." – John 14:6 " ¹⁵That whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have eternal life. ¹⁶For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. ¹⁷For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved." – John 3:15-17.

Please pray (or, call us to pray with you) to enter into that new relationship with God the Father. "Dear God, the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, my heavenly Father, I confess that I am a sinner and have been separated from You. I ask forgiveness of my sins and for forgiveness of blaming and judging You for things that have gone wrong. I repent and accept this gift of repentance. I confess with my mouth that your son Jesus is my savior and died for me. I believe in my heart that You raised Him from the dead. I receive Jesus into my heart and ask Him to become the center of my life. I ask, in the Name of Jesus. Amen."

2 Corinthians 5:17 says, "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come!"

ANA IS LEGISLATIVELY SPEAKING

The Governor has signed the following two Bills that ABATE of Florida, Inc. was supporting into law.

CS/CS/SB 1100 Department of Highway Safety & Motor Vehicles [CPSC]: The Bill that removes the "horizontal" wording of the motorcycle tag was signed by Officers and presented to Governor on 06/08/09.

Here is the wording of this bill as it relates to motorcycles:

"Section 4. Subsection (3) of section <u>316.2085</u>, Florida Statutes, is amended to read: <u>316.2085</u> Riding on motorcycles or mopeds.—

The license tag of a motorcycle or moped must be permanently affixed to the vehicle and may not be adjusted or capable of being flipped up. No device for or method of concealing or obscuring the legibility of the license tag of a motorcycle shall be installed or used."

CS/SB 2282 - First-responder Services [CPSC]

A county may not impose a fee or seek reimbursement for any costs or expenses that may be incurred for services provided by a first responder, including costs or expenses related to personnel, supplies, motor vehicles, or equipment in response to a motor vehicle accident, except for costs to contain or clean up hazardous materials in quantities reportable to the Florida State Warning Point at the Division of Emergency Management, and costs for transportation and treatment provided by ambulance services licensed pursuant to ss. 401.23(4) and 401.23(5).

Proposed change to State and Chapter By Laws

Purposed change:

To make Executive Board and Board of Directors of ABATE of Florida, Inc. on the state and chapter levels have a valid motor vehicle operator's license and a valid motorcycle endorsement

Proposed change:

- 1. Any person accepting a nomination for an Executive Board and Board of Directors position for ABATE of Florida, Inc. or any of its chapters will furnish proof of a valid motor vehicle operator's license and a valid motorcycle endorsement before the next Delegates or Chapter Meeting. This will be accomplished by submitting a photocopy of their driver's license and a current copy of an online drivers license check at: https://www6.hsmv.state.fl.us/DLCheck/main.jsp Failing to comply with this amendment or the lack of a valid drivers license or motorcycle endorsement will render any nominee ineligible to hold office at the state or chapter level. EXCEPTION: Any person who does not operate a motorcycle or a motor vehicle would be exempt from this clause.
- 2. The president of ABATE of Florida, Inc., after verifying that any State or Chapter member of a Board of Directors who operates a motorcycle or motor vehicle does not have a valid driver's license and motorcycle endorsement may, ay his discretion, remove that party from their elected or appointed position.



U.S. House Committee Moves Surface Transportation Bill

The Motorcycle Riders Foundation (MRF) has learned that, with little pomp and even less circumstance, the Unites States House of Representatives subcommittee on Highways and Transit voice voted the Surface Transportation Bill on to the full House Transportation and Infrastructure Committee (HTIC). The 800-page bill lays out a plan for revamping the nation's highway systems and safety programs not seen in the last few decades. The spending bill, which is yet to receive a number or name – and even more importantly a price tag – is mammoth.

The Highway Trust Fund (HTF) will be out of money 6 weeks before the fund was supposed to be tapped out. Future predictions for the HTF, which is funded through a national gas tax, are bleak. With more fuel-efficient cars and record-breaking gas prices, Americans have done the unthinkable the past few years – buy less gas. That conundrum will leave the HTF with about \$250 billion to be generated over the next 6 years. Congressman Jim Oberstar, Chairman of the HTIC, wants to spend \$500 billion. Talks between the House, Senate and White House have completely broken down. Oberstar would like to raise the gas tax, and both the Senate and the White House shot that down immediately. This stalemate will likely delay the bill significantly; some say well into 2012. At the same time, it could move quickly, but that's not likely.

The bill does have some motorcycle-specific provisions, the lion's share of which are very positive. The MRF has been meeting with the committee staff writing the bill for the past few years to ensure that motorcyclists benefit from the legislation. For the first time, the highway safety funds obligate a percentage that can only be used for motorcycle safety programs. Depending on the percentage (all financial details at this point are to be determined), the motorcycle safety community could see a huge infusion of federal cash.

There is one provision that the MRF will be aggressively working to remove. In one section of the bill, some rules are laid out for Public Private Partnerships (PPP). PPPs are stretches of toll road that a community leases to a private sector partner. The partner pays the leasing government up front and in turn gets to keep all the tolls for the length of the lease. The city of Chicago leased a toll road for 99 years to a private company for \$1.8 billion in 2005. The provision of concern gives the private sector partner the power to request from the Secretary of Transportation a ban on motorcycles from the road. The private partner must certify that the presence of motorcycles is causing a safety hazard. The Secretary must approve the request. Current law allows for the same situation, but gives the requesting power to the state agency, not a private for-profit corporation.

Public Private Partnerships have fallen out of favor with many municipalities and individuals, but this section is still of grave concern. It's troubling to think that roads built with federal tax dollars could exclude motorcycles. Precedent has been set in our favor in the past; convincing Congress will be our task.

The MRF will keep you informed on the movement of the bill and of the motorcycle-specific provisions in the bill.

Bikes for Beaters?

The Motorcycle Riders Foundation (MRF) took note that the President recently signed the Car Allowance Rebate System bill, also known as CARS, or by its former moniker, "cash for clunkers." This law provides individual Americans with vouchers up to \$4500 toward the purchase of a new automobile when trading in an older, less efficient vehicle. The idea behind the law is two-fold, to stimulate an ailing auto industry and green up the country at the same time. CARS does not allow for any participation by motorcycle customers or dealers. (For technical information on the CARS program, visit www.cars.gov.)

If Senator Bob Casey (D-PA) has his way, however, you will soon be able to trade an older vehicle that gets less MPGs for a brand new motorcycle. Casey has introduced S. 1248, the Green Transportation Efficiency Act of 2009, aka the Green TEA bill. The Casey bill would provide a \$2500 voucher when trading in an older car or bike to purchase a brand new motorcycle from a participating, registered dealership.


The trade-in must meet the following qualifiers:

- * is in drivable condition;
- * has been continuously insured consistent with the applicable State law and registered to the same owner for a period of not less than 1 year immediately prior to the trade-in;
- * was manufactured less than 25 years before the date of the trade-in; and The new fuel efficient motorcycle must meet the following qualifiers:
- * equitable or legal title of which has not been transferred to any person other than the ultimate purchaser (in other words, brand stinking new);
- * carries a manufacturer's suggested retail price of not less than \$7,000 and not more than \$20,000; and
- * has a manufacturer's estimated combined fuel economy of at least 40 miles per gallon.

The Casey bill would authorize the program for one year from date of enactment. The MRF does not have an official position at this time pending further details, but has been working with Senator Casey's office to get some additional clarity on the impact of this legislation.

The time frame for this particular bill is relatively brief. Anything longer, or worse – permanent, would seriously call into question the forcing of an end of useful life on vehicles that are still drivable and collectable. At the same time, the MRF does appreciate the fact the Senator Casey considers motorcycles and cars equal forms of transportation and both deserving of the same benefits.






