10 LEGISLATIVE REPORT

LEGISLATIVE REPORT-APRIL 2012

NO SAFETY MONEY!!!!!

With the end of the 2011-2012 Legislative session, Governor Rick Scott signed into law the 2012-2013 FY Budget-HB 5001 Tuesday, April 17, 2012. Originally it included the \$250,000 to ABATE of Florida, Inc. for motorcycle safety. Unfortunately, the Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles Dept. advised us that the Governor VETOED next year's money. In a message from Doc, our State President and Lobbyist, after clarification from the Governor's office, this is because he wants more organizations to do what we do. Doc states "DHSMV said they are having a meeting on safety next month that Darren "Scribe" Brooks, State Legislative Trustee, will be at and wanted me to attend as they want to talk to the group about them being involved and carrying on our programs. I told them I would not be there and it was a slap in the face to ABATE to attempt to take over programs that we have worked hard to maintain and support. It is my fault for taking the office of the Governor at their word and will state so in the President's letter I am writing. I am sorry for any embarrassment that I have caused the members of ABATE of Florida, Inc. One side note, someone I trust in the governor's office told me that the Channel Two video hurt as well".

CONTROVERSIAL BILLS

Random Drug Testing: Signed by the Governor 3/19/12 that would allow random drug testing of state employees. Scott prompted a federal court fight last year when he issued an executive order to begin drug testing, quietly notified the Secretary of State that he had signed the bill. The Republican-dominated Legislature overwhelmingly approved the measure (HB 1205) with supporters saying the private sector already uses such programs to improve safety and worker productivity. But legislative opponents and groups such as the American Civil Liberties Union of Florida argued repeatedly that the idea would violate state employees' constitutional rights. The bill would allow, but not require, agencies to conduct random testing every three months. Agencies would use a computer system to choose employees to be tested, with the total not exceeding 10 percent of the agency workforce.

Inspirational Message Bill" Another law that would allow student prayer

at mandatory school events prompted several groups opposed to the law to warn school districts against implementing it. The measure signed by Scott (SB 98) would pave the way for local districts to approve policies allowing students to decide whether to have another student deliver an "inspirational message" at school events.

STAND YOUR GROUND LAW

As the white-hot center of national scrutiny centered on February's killing of an unarmed teen (Trayvon Martin) in Sanford, FL, the state's self defense law, particularly its "stand you ground" proposition needs a fresh look, black lawmakers said. Gov. Scott said the facts need to be understood first, but didn't dismiss the idea of a new look at the stat's standyour-ground law. Former state Sen. Durell Peaden, the Panhandle Republican who sponsored the 2005 legislation, scoffed at the notion that it was even applicable in this case. Rep. Dennis Baxley, R-Ocala who sponsored the law in the House also said it wasn't intended for cases involving pursuit. "Nothing in that statute authorizes people to pursue and confront people". Baxley said the law covers home invasion, carjacking, and cases of clear self-protection. Some said the measure was essentially an expansion of the "Castle Doctrine", which hold that a person's home is their castle and they have a right to defend it. Under the law now, the castle could include a car, someone's personal space, if they're legitimately threatened. "If you're anywhere you have a right to be and you're under attack, you have the authority to meet force with force and defend yourself," said Baxley.

WAIVE LICENSING FEES FOR VETS

One of the measures signed into law by Gov.Scott waives some license fees for military veterans. The bill (HB 887) allows the initial application fee and unlicensed activity fee to be waived for veterans returning from service for the first two years after they're out of the military. It would save them a few hundred dollars, to more than a thousand, depending on the type of license, and applies to more than 20 professional licenses from those in real estate to hairdressers.

nol. Contact U.S. House Speaker John Boehner and your representative today!

On April 19, the American Motorcyclist Association (AMA) sent a letter to U.S. House Speaker Boehner urging the House to consider H.R. 3199 that would require the EPA to seek independent analysis on the effects of E15 gasoline as soon as possible. This bill need the support of the House so the American people will know exactly how the use of 15 percent ethanol blend (E15) gasoline will affect the operation of their vehicles. The new E15 gasoline may soon appear at a fuelling station near you, and you need to be careful how you use this new fuel blend. That is because the EPS, back in October 2010, approved E15 for use in model year 2007 and newer light duty vehicles (cars, light-duty trucks and medium-duty passenger vehicles). In January 2011, it added model year 2001-2006 light duty vehicles to the approved list. *Riders should pay* attention to this list because NO MOTORCYCLES OR ATVS A are currently listed. The AMA is concerned about E15 because it burns hotter than gasoline that contains a lesser amount of ethanol. In engines not designed to dissipate that extra heat, damage in the form of premature wear can result. Although this is a concern in all motorcycles, it is particularly problematic for air-cooled engines found in many bikes. Moreover, use of E15 may even void the manufacturer warranty. Since the approved lists includes many light-duty vehicles in use today, refineries, distributors and fueling stations may choose to offer primarily E15 gasoline because of this action by the EPA. This should concern all motorcyclists and off-highway enthusiasts since this may effect the availability of gasoline with less or no ethanol (E10 or E0).

The AMA supports H.R. 3199 and urges its members and all motorcycle and all-terrain vehicle riders to contact Boehner and their representatives to voice their support for this bill. The AMA encourages riders to personalize their message by drawing on their own personal riding experiences.

MAY IS MOTORCYCLE SAFETY AND AWARENESS MONTH

Governor Rick Scott signed the 2012 State of Florida Proclamation declaring May as Motorcycle Safety and Awareness Month. You may view this proclamation on the State Web Site: www.abateflorida.com.
