ABATE of Florida, Inc. is a statewide, non-profit organization of motorcycle enthusiasts from all walks of life. Our members are carpenters, electricians students, doctors, lawyers, auto mechanics, retirees, teachers and businessmen and women. We promote motorcycle safety, training and awareness. **WE ARE NOT A CLUB OR A GANG.** We fund our work through toy and poker runs, fun rides, camping and other motorcycle related activities. We are your neighbors, co-workers and friends. We work, we pay mortgages and taxes and we are involved with our community. We serve our country and believe in freedom. We use all legal means to protect our rights, without infringing on the rights of others.

ABATE of Florida, Inc. was the driving force behind the changes in Florida's helmet law. Florida motorcyclists can now choose whether or not they want to wear a helmet.

ABATE of Florida, Inc. serves on the advisory board for the Motorcycle Riders Training Program. This is the program that oversees the training sites for motorcyclists. These sites are funded only by the motorcyclists, through monies collected by the motorcycle endorsement on your drivers license and the fees collected at the training sites. ABATE is the organization that got the monies returned to that program, when the state of Florida saw fit to use it for non motorcycling purposes. Also put in legislation that effectively keeps the state from seizing the funds in the future. ABATE acts as your watchdog by monitoring how that money is spent and makes suggestions that can improve the Motorcycle Riders Training Program for all motorcyclists.

Any individual 18 or older interested in motorcycle rights, safety or education, regardless of race, sex or club affiliation. It doesn't matter what or even if you ride, joining ABATE ensures your opinion on motorcycle laws are being heard



We presented Karl Bartling with his MSAP Instructors patch at our Membership meeting. Congratulations Karl!


And now for some unexpected news...





ABATE of Florida, Inc. and its' members have made a commitment to the motorcyclist of Florida to try and help make riding the roads of Florida less dangerous. For many years they have worked to make an impact by informing the non-riding public about motorcycle awareness and safe ways to share the road with motorcycles.

Members throughout the state are trained to become instructors in our MSAP program. They then visit schools, expos and other organizations spreading motorcycle awareness.

Abate of Florida, Inc. has held four workshops on Motorcycle Safety and has a fifth planned for May of 2008. At these seminars experts from all over the country speak on Motorcycle Safety. Presentations were given on Two Trauma 1st Responder, Motorcycle Safety and Awareness Program, being properly insured, from the Eyes of the Law, and much more.

In 2006, ABATE of Florida, Inc., in cooperation with the Florida Department of Highways increased their efforts in motorcycle awareness with items such as billboards, public service announcements, posters, an additional Motorcycle Awareness video and various other items.

We work each year with the Governor to proclaim May as Motorcycle Safety and Awareness month.

With the increase of vehicles on our highways, motorcycle safety has become an even larger concern. Too many motorcyclists are being injured or killed due to the negligence of others.

Not only must we educate the non-riding public, we must educate the riding public about the laws of Florida and other states as well as federal laws so they can be safe when they ride. Safety begins the moment you get on a motorcycle or get behind the wheel of any four wheeled motor vehicle.

ABATE of Florida, Inc. is working diligently to get the message, "WATCH FOR MOTORCYCLES".

If you are planning on visiting or live in our beautiful State of Florida whether you choose to ride or drive here are some facts to keep in mind:

- Obey all traffic laws, signs & signals
- Constantly check and expect to see motorcycles
- Motorcycles are smaller than cars or trucks and it can be more difficult to judge their approaching speed
- Look, look, & look again at traffic intersections before you turn or pull out
- Allow a three second "Space Cushion" when following a motorcycle

Florida law requires a motorcycle endorsement on your driver's license to legally operate a motorcycle. All riders have to pass a written exam as well as a riding test or attend an approved rider's education class to qualify for a motorcycle endorsement. Persons under the age of 21 have to complete a rider training course in order to receive that endorsement.

Many locations offer an experienced rider course as well as a beginner rider course.

So, just to see what we had and to see if it related to what we could tell about each other, we emptied our pockets. The biker friend had some shinny stones and a cigarette lighter. Kathy had a comb, the directions for the run we were going on, and a cell phone. Tom had anointing oil and some emergency crisis guidelines with suggested prayer outlines.

We could only tell just a little about each other from the items presented. Or, could we? It is amazing the perceptions we have and the judgments we form when we only get glimpses of people without really knowing them. Could we assume our friend is a smoker? Or, does he use his lighter for some other function? What about the stones? We could only guess. As far as Kathy's comb; we know from experience she likes to look presentable and combs out the helmet hairdo whenever we stop. With the cell phone, she likes to stay in touch. Or, did she have her cell phone because she was on call for her job, that weekend?

We think you will agree that many times, looks and appearances are many times, deceiving. It is said that when we look at a person and hear them talk, we form our opinion of them within the first 20 seconds. Within that time, we don't see what's in their pockets. Just think of how many times we are looked at by cagers, while we are on the road on our motorcycles. What do they think or think they know about us, just because of appearances? How different would be their thinking if they saw us in a cage? What if we saw a gun in someone's pocket? Does it mean he/she is a criminal? A police officer? Someone who is being stalked by a person wishing harm to him/her?

How about, "What's in their heart?" We think that within those 20 seconds, we can tell a lot about a person because of what we perceive is in their heart.

Perhaps we are more concerned about how people will perceive us. Perhaps we are concerned how people perceive what is in our hearts. Perhaps there is something troubling us from the inside and it is affecting our relationships on the outside.

In reading the 51st Psalm, we think that David must have been having some relationship problems with others and God, along with others having a poor perception of him. The root of this problem is because his heart was troubled due to the illicit relationship he had with Bathsheba. He knew it was wrong and he had to get his heart back in a right relationship with God. There must have been feelings of guilt. When we are not in a right relationship and things are "out-of-sorts," we tend to act out, without being fully aware that we are putting out bad "vibes" which others will notice.

Carefully read and "listen" to what David had to say. Perhaps it may say something to you about what's in your heart. Psalm 51: 1-12. (Amplified Bible)

Messiah's Messengers

A Psalm of David; when Nathan the prophet came to him after he had sinned with Bathsheba.

¹Have mercy upon me, O God, according to Your steadfast love; according to the multitude of Your tender mercy and loving-kindness blot out my transgressions. ²Wash me thoroughly [and repeatedly] from my iniquity and guilt and cleanse me and make me wholly pure from my sin! ³For I am conscious of my transgressions and I acknowledge them; my sin is ever before me. ⁴Against You, You only, have I sinned and done that which is evil in Your sight, so that You are justified in Your sentence and faultless in Your judgment. ⁵Behold, I was brought forth in [a state of] iniquity; my mother was sinful who conceived me [and I too am sinful]. ⁶Behold, You desire truth in the inner being; make me therefore to know wisdom in my inmost heart. ⁷Purify me with hyssop, and I shall be clean [ceremonially]; wash me, and I shall [in reality] be whiter than snow. ⁸Make me to hear joy and gladness and be satisfied; let the bones which You have broken rejoice. ⁹Hide Your face from my sins and blot out all my guilt and iniquities. Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right, persevering, and steadfast spirit within me. ¹¹Cast me not away from Your presence and take not Your Holy Spirit from me. ¹²Restore to me the joy of Your salvation and uphold me with a willing spirit.

How are your relationships? How do you feel about yourself? How are you affecting friends, loved ones, and those you are meeting for the first time?

May we suggest the following prayer before God?

Lord God, my heavenly Father, I wish to feel clean before you and all those I come in contact with. As the Psalmist said and is also my prayer, "Create in me a clean heart." As I confess my sins to You and receive Jesus into my heart, believing that He died for my sins and that He is your Son, please forgive me of my sins and blot out all my guilt and iniquities. Please give me the joy you gave to David and let me experience your salvation, fully. This I ask of You, through your Son. In Jesus name... Amen.
2 Corinthians 5:17 says, "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come!"

THE MRF MEETS WITH U.S. SECRETARY OF TRANSPORTATION RAY LAHOOD

On Thursday, April 23, 2009, Motorcycle Riders Foundation (MRF) Vice President of Government Relations Jeff Hennie, along with ABATE of Illinois Legislative Coordinator Bob Ward and ABATE of Illinois Board Member Rick Olsen, sat down with newly seated Secretary of Transportation Ray LaHood to discuss the U.S. Department of Transportation (USDOT) and its role with the motorcycle community.

Secretary LaHood previously served in the U.S. House of Representatives, where he was a strong champion of motorcycling on many fronts. He is a past recipient of the MRF's highest congressional honor, the MRF Champion award. The award is given to members of the U.S. Congress who display extreme dedication to motorcyclists. So it comes as no surprise that he pledged to continue that role in his new position.

Discussion topics during the MRF and ABATE of Illinois' meeting with Secretary LaHood included the recent National Transportation Safety Board's activities lobbying state committees for helmet laws, the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration's quarterly meetings and 2010 funds, and the Federal Highway Administration's Motorcycle Advisory Council. The Secretary promised an open-door policy for motorcyclists and invited us to contact him with any issues with which he might be helpful.

We at the MRF look forward to working closely with Secretary LaHood, and wish him the very best as he takes on the challenging role of overseeing our nation's entire transportation system.

HR 1253 - HIPAA Update

The Motorcycle Riders Foundation (MRF) is pleased to report that the U.S. House of Representatives has taken a major step toward repairing the loophole created when the regulations for the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 were written. This loophole allows insurers to deny health care benefits to victims of motorcycle crashes simply because they were riding a motorcycle. This loophole also allows insurers to conceal this exclusion of benefits from the insured until a claim has been submitted.

On March 31, 2009 the U.S. House, by a vote of 422 to 3, passed HR 1253, the Health Insurance Restrictions and Clarifications Act of 2009. This bill will require the insurance provider to fully disclose, prior to sale of the plan and prior to participant's enrollment in the plan, all of the limitations and restrictions of the plan.

While this bill does not close the loophole, it does do two very important things; it formalizes the sense of the Congress that this issue needs to be corrected, and it will have the effect of fully disclosing the depth of this loophole with the participants.

"The most troubling aspect of this source of injury loophole has always been the unknown. Not knowing if you are covered or not by your health insurance in the wake of a tragedy is just unacceptable, and HR 1253 sheds light on the substantial coverage gaps that exist today," said Jeff Hennie, MRF Vice President of Government Relations. He added, "The MRF remains committed to fully closing the loophole and making it illegal for any insurance provider not to cover motorcycle injuries."

The bill is now awaiting action by the Senate Committee on Health, Education, Labor, and Pensions. The MRF encourages all motorcyclists to contact their U.S. Senators to encourage them to pass HR 1253.

CONSUMER PRODUCT SAFETY COMMISSION UPDATE

The Motorcycle Riders Foundation (MRF) has learned that the Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) voted last Friday, April 17, 2009, on the issue of banning sales of youth ATVs and motorcycles because of lead levels. The CPSC voted to keep the ban in place; however, they did issue a two-year stay of enforcement of the ban. This stay of enforcement will allow manufacturers and retailers of youth ATVs and motorcycles to continue building and selling these items. It also gives the industry two years to comply with the new law and if, for some reason, it is technologically infeasible to manufacture a certain part with less lead than allowed by law, the industry will have a chance to make an argument to the CPSC.

The two-member CPSC board decided unanimously. Both the acting Chairperson Nancy Nord and Commissioner Thomas Moore voted to deny the petition from industry to completely overturn the ban; however, both cited safety as the reason for their votes to issue the two-year stay. Nord and Moore both claim, "A bigger safety concern than lead exposure is that the elimination of youth ATV sales will likely increase the number of adult ATVs purchased to be used by younger children, therefore increasing risk of injury and death." Industry has 45 days to apply for the stay.

Legislation does currently exist that would force the CPSC to exempt all youth ATVs and motorcycles. Denny Rehberg (R-MT) has introduced HR 1587, and the bill has 35 co-sponsors to date. The MRF encourages you to ask your Member of the US House to co-sponsor this important legislation.
